Code of Conduct

Purpose: To ensure a high standard of athletic behavior for all athletes participating in WFC events.

- 1. Be courteous and demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times. No Taunting.
- 2. Use appropriate language and tones with athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, and spectators.
- 3. Do not criticize or blame others. Avoid obscene gestures or provocative language.
- 4. Treat everyone equally, regardless of gender, race, religion, or sexual orientation.
- 5. Do not use or condone tobacco, drugs, or alcohol.
- 6. Follow all futsal rules and regulations established by WFC, coaches, and participating volunteers.
- 7. No fighting, vandalism, or physical abuse. Avoid inciting violence or abusive actions.
- 8. Players may choose to wear shin guards or extra padding such as knee pads.
- 9. Refrain from negative or harmful actions toward teammates and others on social media.
- 10. Support all players enthusiastically and respect the decisions of officials and coaches.
- 11. Treat opponents with kindness, congratulating them in victory or defeat.
- 12. Clean up after yourself such as empty water bottles and trash.

Disciplinary Actions:

- Violations may result in:
 - Verbal or written warnings
 - Suspension or ejection from events
 - Season-long suspensions
